INTRODUCTION

In the absence of an original charter or copies, or indeed of any record of the granting of one, it is difficult to say exactly when Llanidloes became a borough. In his *Topographical Dictionary of Wales*, 1833 Samuel Lewis states that the town was first incorporated in 1344-45, by a charter of John de Charlton, Lord of Powis, but the writer gives no authority for this statement. There does not appear to be any record of this charter, and if there was a charter, it is believed that it could only have been a confirmation of a former one, as burghal life in Llanidloes is evident as early as 1309 in the inquisition post mortem of Gruffydd de la Pole, which speaks of Llanidloes as having 66 burgesses at that time. Earlier still, in 1280 and 1286, two royal charters or grants (the originals of which are preserved amongst the Charter Rolls at the National Archives, Kew) were made to Owen de la Pole or Owen of Arwystli, father of Gruffydd, for the right to hold a weekly market and annual fairs at his town of “Thlanidleys in Wales”. In the light of these early records, it is fair to assume that Llanidloes acquired municipal privileges sometime between the end of thirteenth and the beginning of the fourteenth centuries.

Whatever the truth of the matter, the government of the borough, until the reform of municipal corporations in 1835, was carried on through the Court Leet, with its burgesses and officials, such as the mayor, recorder, deputy recorder, town clerk, coroners, serjeants-at-mace, town crier, constables and scavenger. In 1835, the Municipal Corporations Act remodelled the governing body and instituted the modern borough council. Radical as this change may have been, a more drastic move was still to come in April 1974, when, on the reorganisation of local government, Llanidloes lost its borough status and became part of the newly created Montgomery District Council, to function henceforth under the title of Llanidloes Town Council.

The archives of the borough are confined to the modern period of the borough’s history, as, unfortunately, nothing has survived from the pre 1835 days. In fact, what we are left with, is a not very extensive collection of records of the reformed borough from 1835 to its demise in 1974.

However, in spite of this considerable limitation, sufficient material has survived to reflect the more recent history of the borough, especially in good, although not continuous, runs of council minutes, from 1835-1955, and committee minutes 1893-1974. A glimpse into public health matters is afforded by two journals of the sanitary inspector and the inspector of dairies, 1915-1947.

Although not as comprehensive nor as wide ranging as they could be, the Llanidloes borough archives have already been put to good use by E R Horsfall-Turner in his book *A Municipal History of Llanidloes*, 1908.
