

## WELSHPOOL BOROUGH

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Welshpool was first granted the status and privileges of a “free borough” by the Charter of Gruffydd ap Gwenwynwyn, Prince of Powis in the thirteenth century. These privileges were later confirmed and extended by Charters of John de Charleton, Lord of Powis in 1314 and 1324 and of his successor, Edward de Charleton in 1406. In 1615, the burgesses received a Royal Charter of Incorporation from James I, whereby they became a corporate body under the title of “the bailiffs and burgesses of the Borough of Poole”. Under this, the borough was governed until 1835, when the Municipal Corporations Act remodelled the governing body and instituted the modern borough council, consisting of a mayor, alderman and councillors. The next and most drastic change came almost one hundred and forty years later, when, on the reorganisation of local government in April 1974, Welshpool lost its borough status and became part of the newly created Montgomery District. The powers of the Borough Council passed mainly to the Montgomery District, partly to the Welshpool Community Council.

The archives of the borough, until recently, in terms of area one of the largest non-county boroughs in the United Kingdom, were deposited in the National Library in two parts. The first and largest part was received in 1974, shortly after the borough ceased to exist, and the second in May 1975. The two groups have been amalgamated and are listed together. Dating from 1406 to recent times, the muniments reflect many aspects of the municipal history of Welshpool through six centuries, although the documentary evidence is more heavily weighted in favour of the nineteenth and twentieth centuries.

Nevertheless, the earlier records, although smaller in quantity, contain some of the most noteworthy items in the collection, and include some interesting bye-laws dating from 1570, two burgess rolls, 1678-1835, burgage rents for 1701 and 1736, plan of the town in 1629 (tracing), an award with plan of Pool Common, 1761 and a perambulation of the borough boundary in 1818. Pride of place should however, be given to the Charters of 1406 and 1615, the former being the oldest surviving document in the collection.

The growth of the borough during modern times and the resultant increase in its activities is amply demonstrated in an excellent series of Council minutes, starting in 1728 and continuing to recent years. Financial affairs are well represented by ledgers, starting in 1823, and accounts and rating records mainly for the first half of the present century. Another large section is devoted to loose papers, original bundles and files, 1866-1967, which testify to the energies of the modern day council, particularly in the provision of houses, the clearance of slums and the supply of water.

Special mention should be made of “A statement...by the Mayor and Council, respecting the Books, Documents....relating ...to the Borough” [AX 10] made in 1902, which (quoting earlier lists of borough records are kept in the Minute Books, from 1728) is of interest in showing what has or has not survived in this present list.

A good deal of research into the earlier records has been done by Morris Charles Jones, whose results are published in various volumes of the Montgomeryshire Collections, to which references have been given in this list.

The documents have been divided into various classes (see Summary of Classes) and when requesting them, the reader should specify the class reference and the number of the item, eg MX 2.

### MINUTE BOOKS

Prior to the Municipal Corporations Act of 1835, the government of the borough was vested in two bailiffs, a steward, recorder, aldermen and burgesses meeting in "Common Hall". The Act abolished the office of bailiff and the reformed Corporation consisted of a mayor, four aldermen and twelve councillors. The earlier minutes were called Tensors Books. /M1 is now the oldest surviving minute book in the possession of the Council, and earlier volume having been lost soon after its completion in 1728. Apparently a portion of the book came to light in 1893 and was still in existence in 1902, but has since been lost [see p 6 of /AX10 and Mont Colls XIV, pp 164-165]. The post 1835 Council minute books are at present (June 1975) in the custody of the Montgomery District Council but are likely to be transferred to NLW in the near future. Details of these books were taken when they were seen at Welshpool in 1974.
