

The best descriptions of the water undertaking of the City of Birmingham in the valleys of the rivers Elan and Claerwen are given in A E Fordham, 'The Water Undertaking' in *Up the Claerwen* by Sid Wright (Birmingham 1948; reprinted for Herefordshire County Libraries 1973), pp 91-105, and by James Mansergh in R Eustace Tickell, *The Vale of Nantgwilt: A Submerged Valley* (London 1894). On the advice of Mansergh the Corporation of Birmingham in 1891 introduced a scheme for flooding the valleys of the Elan and Claerwen in order to provide six reservoirs with a total storage capacity of 18,000 million gallons of water. After the approval of the Birmingham Water Act, 1892 work began in constructing four reservoirs viz Caban Coch, Graig Ddu, Peny-y-Garreg and Craig Goch. These were formally opened in 1904 and completed in 1907. The scheme involved the flooding not of empty valleys but attractive countryside with an established, albeit small, population. Two mansions with associations with the poet Shelley viz Nantgwyllt and Cwm-Elan, together with 20 farms and other buildings, a Baptist chapel and a school were flooded. Besides the dams the water undertaking included the construction of a 73 ½ mile aqueduct to Frankley near Birmingham and a railway, and the building of a new village. It was originally intended to add a further three reservoirs in the valley of the Claerwen but a single reservoir, Claerwen, was built in 1946-48.

This deposit originally consisted of loose letter-books and records contained in eight deed boxes. Boxes 1-5 were in good order and contained numbered bundles. These have been kept in the same sequence. Boxes 6-8 were simply marked 'Birmingham Corporation' and one box in particular No 8 was in complete disarrangement.

As might be expected, the archives deal with the administration and preparation for the purchase of the lands in the watershed of the Elan and Claerwen and tributaries, the removal and compensation of the inhabitants as well as the technical details of the engineering and the later administration of the Elan Valley Estate by Birmingham Corporation's agents Stephen William Williams (d. 1899) and John Jones of Rhaeadr. The letter-books of Stephen Williams are particularly interesting in the light that they shed on the water undertaking. There are in addition other matters; Williams's letter-books begin not in 1891/2 but in 1879

and include references to his work as County Surveyor of Radnorshire and as inclosure valuer; there is a volume of letters too relating to his work on behalf of the London County Council which intended to build its own waterworks in the upper Wye valley in the 1890s. Williams's obituary in *Archaeologia Cambrensis* and *The Montgomeryshire Collections* 1900, pp 347-350, bears testimony to his industry as an architect, land agent, surveyor, valuer and archaeologist.
