Museum Liverpool**

These photographs form part of the Eric Hardy Collection, given to the World Museum Liverpool after his death. Mr Hardy was a Merseyside naturalist, broadcaster and journalist, who used these agency photographs as illustrations for his articles.

Most of the dates given here are those stamped on the backs of the photographs, so are not necessarily the dates when the pictures were taken. The inscriptions on the back of the photographs are in typescript, unless otherwise stated.

- /1 Photograph of gaffs, spears and lamps used by salmon poachers; taken by Arthur Selwyn. C Selwyn, his father had a shop at 4 Park Crescent, Llandrindod Wells, and used to stamp the back of some of his son's photographs with "C Selwyn" [11 Dec 1931]
