This collection of scrapbooks has been donated by Lt Col Paterson.

Lt Col James Andrew Paterson OBE was a native of Cumberland and a civil engineer, he came to Radnorshire in 1909 when Llanellwedd Quarries were re-opened by Thomas Lant. He was County Surveyor of Radnorshire from 1930 until his retirement in 1952.

A founder member of the Llandrindod Wells branch of the Royal British Legion, he later became its president for many years and eventually its Patron.

In 1939 he was appointed a magistrate and became chairman of the Llandrindod Wells court. He was appointed a Deputy Lieutenant of Radnorshire and High Sheriff of the county in 1949.

The Crown Manor of Gladestry consisted of the townships of Gladestry, Waun-wen, Hengoed & Colfa. In 1108, the manor was granted to William de Breos by Henry I. Elizabeth I granted lands in the manor, forfeited by Jenn ap Jankyn when he was outlawed for felony, to Hugh and Thomas Lewis. A daughter of Jevan Lewis married Sir Gelli Meyrick, who was later executed for treason.

Introduction: Rhydoldog was a Welsh long house, bought by Thomas Oliver in 1761. The Olivers were originally from Lledrod in Cardiganshire; they acquired Penygareg, in the Elan valley. Thomas Oliver's uncle, Jeremiah, who had made money as a tailor in London, is said to have financed the rebuilding of Rhydoldog house.

Thomas' son John bought the property from the trustees of his father's will, and, being childless, left it to his brothers David and Thomas. Thomas was married to Alice Banks of Kington, and their daughter, Anne, inherited the property from her uncle, David Oliver, on his death in 1858. Anne married her cousin, John Ramsay Sladen, a widower, in 1866. He was a military man, who served in India, and ended his career as a Major General.

After his retirement, Major Gen Sladen was a JP, and served as Deputy Lieutenant and High Sheriff of Radnorshire. He died in 1907. Anne Sladen died in 1920.

John and Anne Sladen's children were: David Ramsay, who was also in the army, and ended his career as a Brigadier General. He served in Khartoum and India. He married Isabel Houston from Northern Ireland, and they had a daughter called Oonah; Thomas Oliver Ramsay, who became a Captain in the army, then worked as a civilian in the Transvaal; Alice Amelia, and Mary Dorothea. .
