Sir Francis Edwards, born 28 April 1927, was a Liberal politician who served as JP and Deputy Lieutenant for Radnorshire and in 1898 was High Sheriff of the county. He represented Radnorshire in Parliament 1892-1895, 1900-Jan 1910 and Dec 1910-1918. He was created a baronet in 1907. He died 10 May 1927.
