/1      True copy of will of Richard Morgan of Aberborthin, p. Llandinam, co. Mont., blacksmith      29 Feb 1848  
To be buried in Llandinam church.  
Bequeaths farm called Wern, p. Churchstoke, co. Mont., to sons by 1<sup>st</sup> wife Richard, John and Thomas – John to be manager.  
To son Edward the shop, tools and stock in trade.  
To wife Jane (sole executrix) remainder of property, furniture etc. and rent of Wern farm for 12 months after testator's death subject to payment of debts and funeral expenses. Also 4 dwelling houses and land called Dolphin, p. Llandinam, for life, then to children viz. the upper dw. house to Edward and ½ field, middle dw. house and ½ field to William and lower dw. house to Elizabeth (with reversion if she dies without heirs to William).  
To dter. Jane the dw. house called the Backichin (the Back Kitchen) and garden, reversion to her brother Edward.
