Breconshire Rural Community Council was established in 1957 with the object of assisting the work of statutory authorities and voluntary organisations engaged in education, physical improvement, health and welfare, and to act as a co-ordinating body. The first meeting of the Executive Council was held on 6 February 1957. The Council was superseded by Powys Rural Council in 1974.
